From the moment I start planning a quilt, I start planning the quilting. Making the quilt even more beautiful through quilting is the part I enjoy most. I quilt all of my quilts on a Bernina 440 QE.

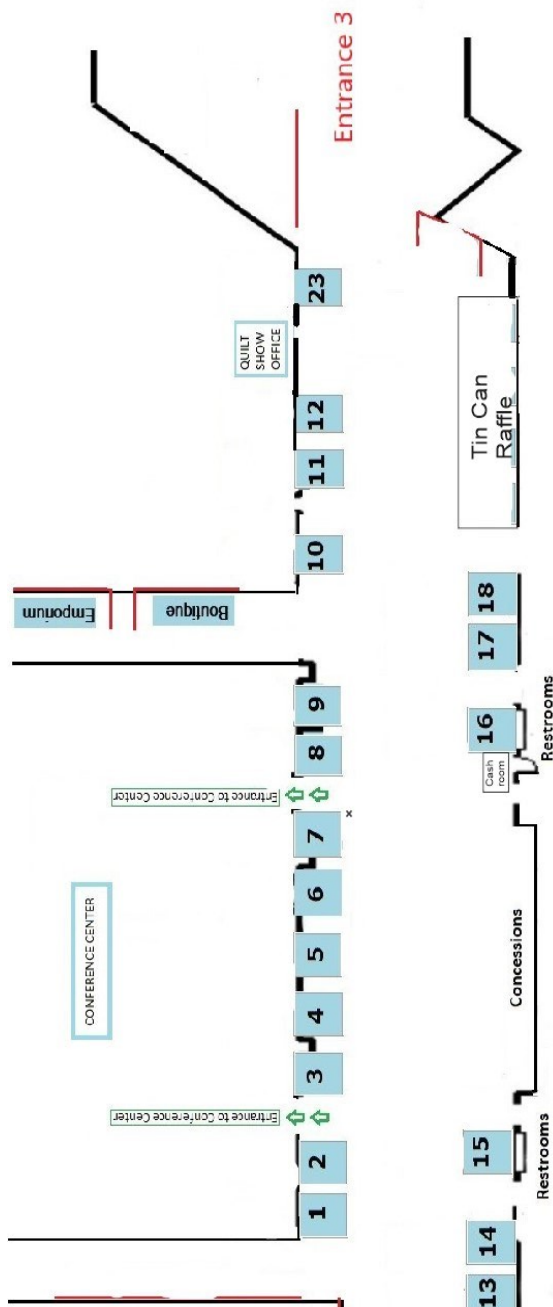

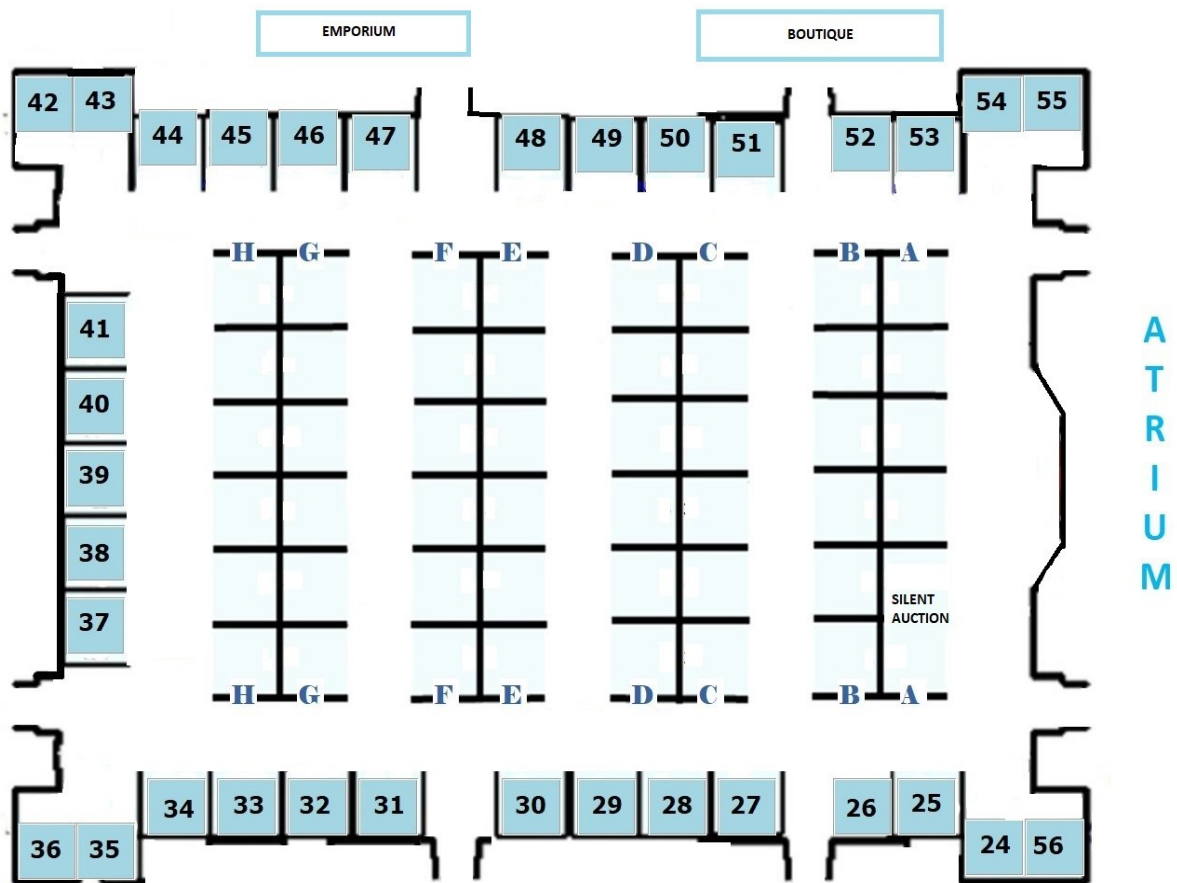
