






June BLOCK OF THE MONTH



June 2021 BOM Jazzed Up Churn Dash Tri County Quilt Guild

I started with a Churn Dash block and added a few things. I think it will be a cool quilt! P.S. I'm going to leave out most of the individual step photos. Let me know if you'd rather have them.



Cut:

White: 4 @ 5" square 4 @ 4-1/2' x 2-1/2' Gray: 4 @ 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" 4 @ 2-1/2" squares Turquoise: 1@ 4-1/2" square

Directions:

Make the HSTs. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the white 5" squares. Place one white 5" square and one 5" turquoise square right side together. Sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line.

Cut on the drawn line. Set your seams and press the seam allowance towards the dark side.

Square up the HST to 4-1/2". You should have 4 HSTs.

Snowball the HST corners. Draw a diagonal on the back of each gray 2-1/2" square. Place this small square right side down in the white corner of each HST as shown in the photo. Sew on the drawn line and fold the gray square along the sewn line up to the corner making sure the tip of the gray corner matches the tip of the white corner. Set the seam and press towards the white corner of the HST. You can trim the seam allowance on just the middle layer or on the back two layers. I like to trim just the middle layer and leave the already squared back fabric .

Here is a photo of the steps starting at the top left and finishing at the bottom right.

June BLOCK OF THE MONTH—

Make the strip units. Place a gray 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle and a white rectangle of the same size right sides together.

Stitch together along one long side. Set your seam and press toward the dark side. Repeat 3 more times. You should have 4 strip units that are 4-1/2" square.

Assemble the block as shown in the photo.



Sew the top row together. Set the seams and press seam allowanced toward the middle. Sew the middle row together. Set the seams and press seam allowanced toward the outside. Sew the bottom row together. Set the seams and press seam allowanced toward the middle. Give the block a good press and trim to 12 1/2" square. You're finished!

Here is the completed block.

- A five inch square of backing fabric attached to a donated finished quilt.




