## Cutting Instructions: (Pieces already cut in your packet)

Dark Fabric - (Navy) Cut one center square $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and cut four $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Medium Fabric - (Red) Cut one $63 / 4$ " square
Light Fabric - (Stripes) Cut four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
Background Fabric - (White) Cut one $63 / 4$ " square and $51 / 4$ " square
LET'S GO PIECE THIS BLOCK! All seams are $1 / 4$ ".


Finished size 12 " x 12 "
The FOLDED CORNERS quilt block appears as an optical illusion by using light, medium and dark colors in the same color family. If you use a slightly lighter shade of the darkest color in the four corners of the block, it appears that each corner is folded into the center - hence the name of the block. I have changed this up a little for July by using Red, White \& Blue.

This easy quilt block is a standard nine patch utilizing 4 half square triangles (HST) and 4 flying geese units- both very commonly used units in quilt making. We will use the no waste method to make four at a time flying geese and four at a time HSTs.

First - To make the four flying geese units take the $51 / 4$ " square of the white fabric and four $27 / 8$ " squares of the navy fabric. (I) Draw a diagonal line on each of the four navy $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Place two navy $27 / 8$ " squares at opposite corners of the white $51 / 4 "$ square with right sides together and make sure the diagonal lines match up to form a straight line. (2) Sew a $1 / 4$ " on either side of the diagonal line. (3) Cut the piece on the diagonal line you marked. Press seams toward the background fabric. (4) Place each of the remaining navy $27 / 8$ " squares at the lower corner of each unit with the diagonal line pointing to the center of the unit and sew $1 / 4$ " on either side of the diagonal line as shown. (5) Cut each piece on the diagonal line. Press seams. You now have four flying geese units using the no waste method!

## Block of the Month

Second - To make the four HST units take the $63 / 4$ " squares of the white fabric and the red fabric. Place right sides together and sew a $1 / 4$ " in from all four edges of the entire square. Cut on each diagonal to reveal four HSTs. Press each open towards the red and square up to measure $41 / 2$ ".


Third-Sew a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip of the striped fabric to the bottom of each flying geese unit as shown. Repeat until you have four of these units.


Fourth - Place all your units in the order shown below. Sew rows I-3 together. Press seams in altering directions. Sew rows together to finish the block. The block should measure a 12 " square when finished.


I really like how this block turned out using the Red, White \& Blue. It would make a great Fourth of July or Memorial Day table runner, also if you have someone in the Armed Forces that you want to make a quilt for, this would fit right in. You could also substitute some special Marine, Army, etc. fabric in place of the stripes.
