

July BLOCK OF THE MONTH



Eight Point Star Block Block Name

This block is an eight point star with a beautiful peacock that has been fussy cut for the center square.

I'm offering you enough fabric that will allow for either of two methods to make the 4 flying geese units. You may use either of these methods.



Cut: For Method I

From Black: 1—6-1/2" square for center square From Purple: 4 squares @ 4" for flying geese units From Green: 1 @ 7-1/4" square for flying geese units 4 @ 3-1/2" for corners

Directions: for Method I:

NOTE: All seams are sewn with a scant 1/4' seam allowance.

Using the green 7-1/4" green fabric as the goose and the four 4" purple squares as the sky, construct four matching flying geese using the "No Waste Four Flying Geese" method. There are many tutorials on YouTube and on the internet if you need help. **The fabrics in this kit will need to be cut to size if you're going to make them with this method.** The green square in the kit is 7-1/2" and is too large and the purple fabric is 9" square. (It will yield four 4" squares with a bit leftover.)

Square each flying geese unit to 3-1/2" x 6-1/2.

There is another method to make four flying geese units which I'll reference at the end so as not to confuse anyone.

Once you have your four flying geese units, you're ready to lay out the block and stitch it up!

See the photo to the right for the layout.

Sew row I together pressing seam allowances to the outside.

Sew row 2 together, pressing seam allowances to the middle.

Sew row 3 together, pressing seam allowances to the outside.



July BLOCK OF THE MONTH—

When sewing the rows together, press the seam allowances to the middle. I think it helps the flying geese points lay flatter. Give your block a good press and square to 12'1/2''.




Method 2 for constructing four flying geese at a time.

Green: | @ 7-1/2" square (Goose) Purple: I @ 9" square (Sky) The two large squares in your kit are already cut to the correct size for this method.

Someone showed me this method a while back and it's the only way I get beautiful flying geese units. It's very easy! In fact you sew just 4 seams and it doesn't require a special ruler. Those Flying Geese specialty rulers help no matter which method you use, though. I think this method is associated with Eleanor

Burns and her rulers, but you can find videos on YouTube that are made by a handful of people. Patch-



videos. I like Jenny Doan's video, best and it's about 9 years old..

You start with two fabrics right sides together with the smaller fabric centered on top of the large one .

(I drew both diagonals to make sure the fabrics were centered.)

Sew 1/4' on each side of ONE diagonal like you're making HSTs. Cut on that drawn line, press, twist the top square around and repeat the process. Then you're ready to trim to four beautiful flying geese units!

Of course, there are more details to this method, but that's about how easy it is!


