



The October 2022 Boutique workshop was well attended and very successful. We made small cross body bags for carrying the essentials. Boutique Chair, Connie Suarez, designed rectangu-



lar quilt blocks for the fronts of the bags which participants quilted and then assembled into bags. Leather straps and decorative buttons for the closures will be added to complete each bag.

Please be aware that there will not be a Boutique workshop for November or December. People are busier than normal during these two holiday months, so no workshops. Boutique workshops in 2023 will move to the third Tuesday of the month. Workshops will continue to be held at Bobbins & Threads, located at 10130 Grant Road, Houston 77070. 




