# April Speaker

### **SHIRLEY THIESSEN - APRIL 5**

Shirley Thiessen, local to the Houston area, has been sewing for 60+ years and since 2012 "obsessed" with quilting. She not only pieces her own quilts (over 200) but also has a long arm with 36 million+++ stitches. Shirley has conducted quilt clas-



ses in Texas as well as at her summer home in northern NY State. Additionally, Shirley has co-hosted several mystery quilt retreats in Texas.

Shirley's trunk show on the evening of the guild meeting will highlight many of the quilts she has decided to keep. She will also share some "lessons learned" for piecing and preparing your quilt tops for a long arm.

Following the evening guild meeting, Shirley will return the following day to teach an "Easy Peasy" method for a Pineapple Quilt that doesn't use any special ruler and goes together quickly.

# EASY PEAZY PINEAPPLE QUILT (NOT Paper-pieced)

During the class, you will be making FOUR blocks that will measure approximately 50x50 depending on your choice of the outer borders, perfect for a baby quilt or a small throw. This size quilt would also be perfect for a table topper.

The fabrics in the supply list (which you will get once you've paid for the workshop) will make four 20" blocks using 2 1/2" strips. Select a small print and contrasting fabrics that complement the pineapple.

### **Tips and Techniques**

April 2023

Interleave Block

I saw this block during Sew & Tell at the Waller County Piecemakers Guild meeting in February and really wanted to try it.

I wasn't sure why it was called "Interleave" so I looked it up. Interleave can mean to insert (usually blank) pages between the pages of a book or to mix digital images by alternating between them.

### How to make the Interleave Block:

At the bottom of the article I'll give you the names of people you can find on YouTube and the internet who demonstrate the technique with more details. Pease watch the videos!

Start with four colors of fabric that are 14 inches square. You'll be able to make two blocks with these 4 squares.



Lay the 4 squares on top of each other right sides up and cut diagonally in one direction creating right triangles.



make into squares. You should have 4 squares, but we will only use two for each interleave block.

Lay two different color schemed squares on top of each other right sides up with the diagonal seam going in opposite directions. Starting on one side, cut across both squares at the same time every I inch to form strips. I started from

the left and discarded the small strip on the right.



### Tips and Techniques



Spread the cut strips apart and stagger the strips so they alternate which block they came from. You may want to number them 1, 2, 3, 4 etc. from the bottom strip to the top strip. Make sure that you haven't missed any strips.



Begin sewing by taking strip #2 and folding it down on top of strip #1 so right sides are together. Sew with a scant 1/4' seam allowance. Press if you want. I press the seam allowance to-

ward strip #1. (You can see in the photo where I've numbered the strips and sewn strip #2 to strip #1.)

Fold strip #3 on top of strip #2 and sew with a scant 1/4" seam allowance and press if you want. Continue until all strips are sewn together. You may prefer to save all pressing until the end.

Give your Interleave Block a good press and square it up as much as possible. Mine finished at 13" high and 12" wide.




