





SCAMMERS ARE EVERY WHERE!!!


The threats of being contacted by a scammer have increased tremendously in the last few months with the free access to Artificial Intelligence software tools.

No worries about pins falling out, and I get to use my fa-


vorite pin cushion when I sew while away from home.




