These are unexpected emails, calls, and texts from impersonators that often refer to an unauthorized charge for membership or notice of membership expiration. They ask you to verify your account by providing personal or payment information.

What to watch out for?

Scammers might send fake email attachments or say you are being charged a costly fee.

How can you avoid being scammed?

Visit the Message Center on Amazon.com or on our app to review authentic emails from Amazon. To verify your Prime membership status, authorize payments, or make changes to your billing and account information, log into your Amazon account, and go to Your Account.

Tips & Techniques August 2024

This tip was passed along to me by Rebecca Sasser. Someone shared it with her, but Rebecca gives credit to fabric designer Katarina Roccella for the idea.

When placing a small square of fabric on the corner of a piece of fabric when you're snowballing corners, use a dab of glue from a washable glue stick to hold the top piece in place so it doesn't shift as you stitch. Touch the top piece of fabric with a hot iron to dry and set the glue.

You can pick up the unit and shake it. The glued squares will stay on! You can sew confidently knowing that your unit will have lovely snowballed corners.

Thanks for sharing this tip, Rebecca! It's sew simple, but effective!


