

Tips & Techniques September 2024

Gutermann Thread

This tip is for the sewers who do turned edge applique and/or hand finish quilt bindings or do any kind of hand sewing. If you like Gutermann thread, then you may just think this tip is kind of cool!

We know many brands of thread have a mechanism to grab the loose end of the thread and secure it to the spool to help us keep our sewing space/basket neat and tidy.

But did you know that a spool of Gutermann thread will also store needles and straight pins for you? If you'll grab the end of the spool where you'd catch the thread to keep it from unwinding and twist, the spool comes apart and you now have two pieces.



You can now insert a few needles and/or straight pins into the cavity of the spool and then slide the bottom back on. I've tried it and the needles and pins have not come out through the hole at the top or the bottom of the spool.

There's two things to know:

- 1. Your needles and pins must be shorter than the length of the inside cavity of the spool, or you can't put the bottom back on.
- 2. You need to put the straight pins in with the head of the pin going in first, or you can't get the bottom back on.


