

Tips & Techniques October 2024

I'm going to admit something most of you don't know about me. I hate to throw things away. I keep thinking there's going to be a use for all 34 votive cups I've saved or the beeswax and shea butter from a project I tried and failed at. The good news is that I have found other projects that I could use those items for. Our antique car club ladies group had a great time making pressed flowers and glitter votive cups at Valentine's Day and then lip balm at our last meeting. They think my craft room is magical! Ha! Ha!

What they don't know is how hard it is for me to throw away scraps of fabric as well. At another guild's quilt show, we saw bags of scraps being sold for \$5 and people were going crazy for them so we're bringing that idea to our guild to have in Treasure Aisle. Sharon Castillo has talked about these 5 gallon clear bags filled with scraps at the last two meetings. She even has the bags at the meetings for members to take several home and fill up to bring back.

This sounds perfect for me. I don't have to throw away scraps, and I don't have to keep a big trash can filled with scraps for that day I might actually make a scrappy quilt.

I have a small container that I set in a corner of my sewing room, put the bag in it and toss my scraps into it, knowing that it will benefit the guild at our quilt show in March 2026!
