

January 2026 BOM - Eccentric Star Block

Adapted from a Moda Blockheads block, originally by Linzee Kull McCray

What you'll need:

Background Fabric (BG)

(4) 5" squares

Fabric A

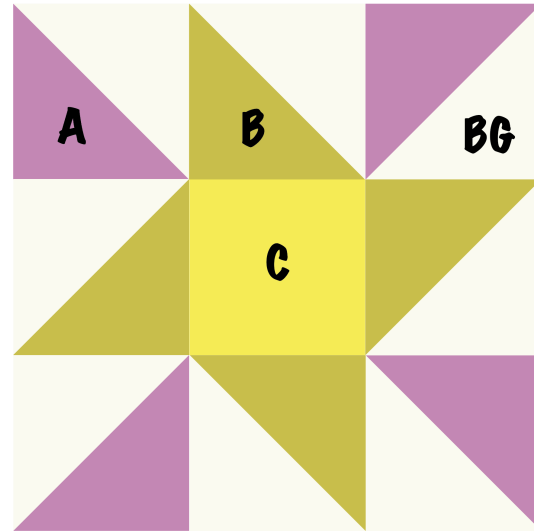
(2) 5" squares

Fabric B

(2) 5" squares

Fabric C

(1) 4 ½" square



Steps:

1. On the wrong side of each BG square, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner.
2. Place BG squares right sides together with each of the A and B squares. Stitch a scant ¼" seam on both sides of the drawn line.
3. Cut the square apart on the line to yield two HSTs, and press the seams to the darker triangles.
4. Trim HSTs to 4 ½".
5. Stitch the units together following the diagram with fabric C square in the center of the 9-patch.
